
Dear Fellow Maynard Residents and Friends,

The Maynard Community Chest was founded in 1967 by a group of civic-minded Maynard residents to ensure that a broad range of human services was available to the people of Maynard, no matter their age or ability. In the 42 years since our mission began, we've seen our community through good economic times and bad.

In 2009, the Maynard Community Chest supported 18 nonprofit organizations that provide food and legal assistance, preschool services to low income families, assistance to seniors in independent living, as well as a host of other services to people of all ages, abilities and types of need. The Maynard Community Chest Board of Directors is comprised of local community volunteers and has no paid staff.

We are thankful to the nearly 300 individual and business donors who funded the efforts of these agencies during this past year. Because of this generosity, a total of \$40,000 was allocated to these 18 organizations, a 14% increase over the previous year, despite the tough economic times.

In June 2009, the Maynard Community Chest participated in the Seventh Annual Community Chest Challenge Triathlon, co-sponsored with Concord-Carlisle Community Chest. We wish to recognize Comcast Cable, Leaktite Corporation, the dozens of individual donors, the volunteers, and, of course, the eight relay teams who biked, ran, and paddled canoes to the finish! Maynard started participating in the Challenge five years ago when one team raised \$800. This past year, we set a new Maynard participation record with eight teams, raising a total of \$8,000.

The Board of Directors welcomed new members Karl Baldrate, Patty Crossland, Laura Howrey, Jill Pierantozzi, and Meghann Thomas last spring. Shari Belanger stepped down as President after nearly five years of service in May 2009. With encouragement from the Board, I stepped into the role of President for the Maynard Community Chest beginning in August.

Looking ahead to the upcoming year, we will face continued economic difficulty in our community. We anticipate more demand than ever on the already burdened agencies we support. We look to the generous donors and sponsors of the Maynard community to meet the needs of our fellow citizens. We hope you will join us in our efforts in caring for the heart of Maynard!

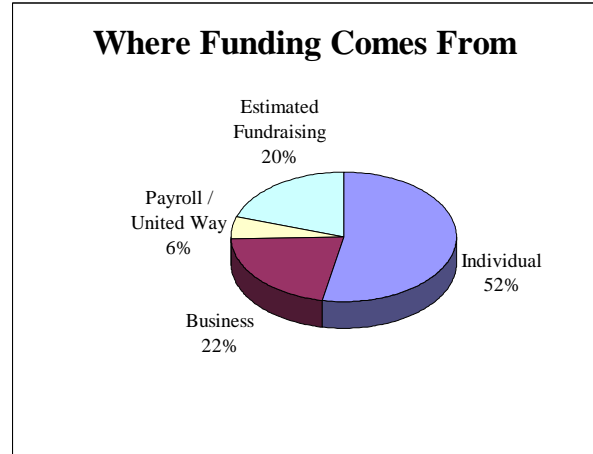
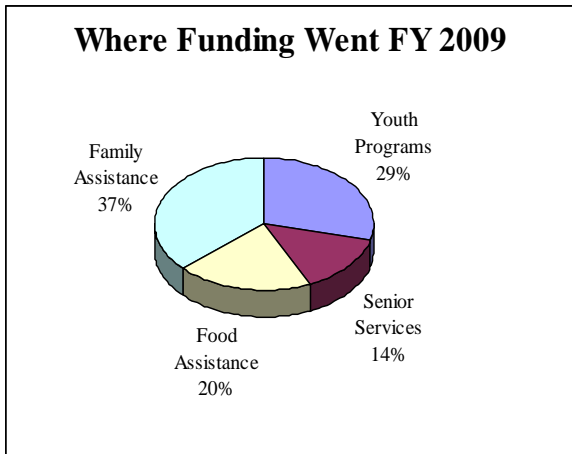

Donations to the campaign from individuals in the amount of \$21,356 have been collected year to date, with a further \$620 pledged. A total of 281 donations and pledges have been received, with an average of \$78 per individual/family. Donations to the campaign at the same time last year totaled \$24,701 from 294 individual/families, indicating a decrease in average donation amount per family of 7% from \$84 to \$78

Business Campaign Donations of \$8,678 has been received year to date from a total of 17 businesses compared to \$13,962 from 26 businesses as of the same date last year.

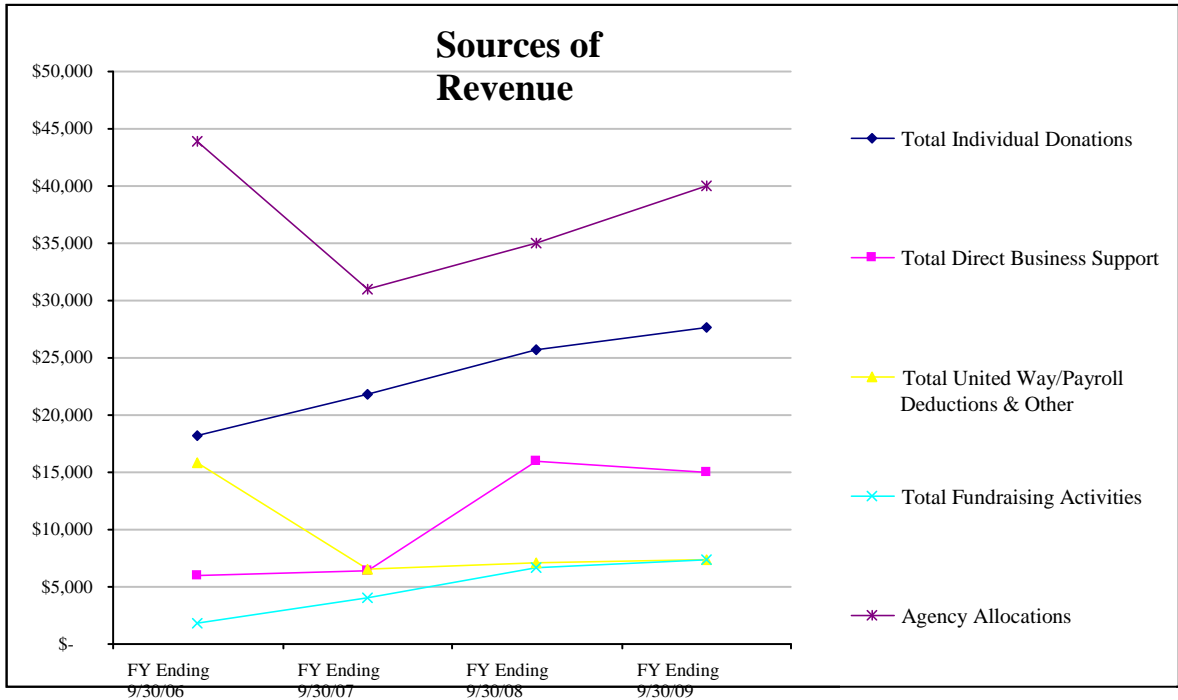
United Way contributions, payroll deductions, matching funds and other sources of revenue accounted for \$2,235 compared to \$1,825 as of the same date last year.

Fundraising activities in the amount of \$135 have been received from Abitibi during 2009. The Community Chest Challenge is scheduled for June 2010. Last year the challenge raised \$8,114.

Our Endowment Fund that we established last year has a balance of \$14,807 as of 12/31/09. \$624 is available for distribution.

Total expenses year to date are \$4,451 which include \$3,613 for Annual Campaign costs reimbursed by Wellesley Management/Clock Tower Place.

We are confident in reaching our goal of distributing \$40,000 to organizations this year.



Annual Campaign

The 42nd Annual Campaign for 2009/2010 took place this past fall. We had anticipated that the economy might play a significant role in our fundraising efforts this year and it was, in fact, reflected in our business donations. We expect our business donations to return to normal levels once the economy becomes more stable. One of the bright spots of this year's campaign was that individual donations were up on average 10%. While we had slightly fewer individual donors, those that gave, donated even more generously.

We are confident in reaching our goal of raising \$40,000 to distribute to the worthy nonprofits that service our community. Although the Annual Campaign runs in the fall, donations of any size are welcome any time throughout the year.

The Maynard Community Chest is thankful to all those businesses and residents who displayed "Support the Maynard Community Chest" lawn signs during the Annual Campaign. We truly appreciate everyone's effort in supporting the Community Chest.

2009 Community Chest Challenge & Morey's Pre-Race Fundraiser

On June 7, 2009, the Maynard Community Chest once again joined forces with the Concord-Carlisle Community Chest in the 7th Annual Community Chest Challenge to raise funds for local human service agencies. The Maynard Community Chest extends many thanks to Comcast Cable, Leaktite Corporation, the individual donors, the volunteers, and the eight relay teams who competed for Maynard in the Community Chest Challenge and who helped make it a success. The generous corporate sponsorship of both Comcast Cable and Leaktite Corporation enabled 100% of the donations raised by the eight Maynard teams to go directly to our 18 supported human service organizations. Maynard started participating in the Community Chest Challenge five years ago, and we have consistently increased our number of Maynard teams and fundraising efforts every year. This year, the eight Maynard teams raised a total of \$8,000.

Each of the eight relay teams consisted of two to six people with two people competing in each leg of the race: an eleven-mile bike ride, a three-mile run and two-mile canoe race. Athletes of all ages and abilities participated on Maynard's eight teams: Team O.I.M., Maynard's Finest, The Milltown Six, Maynard Sisters, Ms. Munch, and Revenge of the 'Nards I, II, and III.
